## RULES

**RABBIT ENTRY FEE, IN ALL CLASSES .....\$5.00**

1. Entries can be made through our online entry system located on our website at [www.kystatefair.org](http://www.kystatefair.org). Entries must be submitted by midnight on July 19. Exhibitor admission tickets may be purchased at time entry is made. Complete information, including the breed, variety and sex of each rabbit as well as the ear number, is required when making online entries.
2. Exhibitors bringing entries into the Kentucky Exposition Center should use Gate 4, located off Crittenden Drive. The Rabbit Department is located in the Pavilion.
3. **The Rabbit Department will be open for the reception of rabbits on Wednesday, August 18 from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. All exhibits must be in the hands of Show Superintendent by 8:00 a.m. Thursday, August 19. Judging to begin at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, August 19. Rabbits will be released at 12:00 Noon on Sunday, August 22 and must be removed by 3:00 p.m. The Fair is not responsible for rabbits left after this time.**
4. Exhibitors are expected to be present at judging to carry their animals or arrange for someone to do so in their absence.
5. There will be NO sale coops. Only rabbits entered in the Show will be allowed into the Kentucky Exposition Center. All rabbits must remain until 12:00 Noon, Sunday, August 22. Exhibitors violating these rules will forfeit all premiums won. All cooped rabbits will be judged as entered.
6. This is an American Rabbit Breeders Association SANCTIONED SHOW and will be governed by their latest revised rules. Only breeds and varieties recognized by the A.R.B.A. are eligible to show. Entry form must be completely filled out with Breed Name, Variety (if applicable), sex and class as well as division number & class number

(including letter). The filing of an entry indicates acceptance of rules and regulations.

7. All exhibitors entering in the youth show (divisions 1802 and 1804) must be under the age of 19 on the day of the show. Youth exhibitors may not enter the same rabbit in both the open and youth shows but can make entries in both shows with different rabbits.
8. No Does and Litters accepted.
9. **No substitutions except in same class, sex and breed.**
10. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly earmarked in the animal's left ear.
11. Any rabbit showing symptoms of disease will be isolated, and not allowed to be in competition. Entry fee will be forfeited.
12. All rabbits that are over-weight or under-weight will be eliminated. There will be no changes after the rabbits are placed on the judges table. All junior class rabbits must meet minimum weight requirements as listed in the ARBA breed standards. Any rabbit significantly underweight for its breed will be removed from the show room.
13. Wall space for exhibitor grooming tables, chairs and supplies is limited and must be shared and kept clean and presentable. No exhibitor carrying cages may be left in the showroom.
14. There must be ten (10) or more exhibits in the breed to win Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex Specials. Listed premiums paid on all classes regardless of number in class.
15. Exhibitors are limited to winning two premiums and two ribbons in each class.
16. The Fair offers a minimum of \$2,640. If premiums won exceed \$3,550, individual premium amounts will be prorated.
